

Dakota Women's' Correctional and Rehabilitation Center Visitation Plan

Phase 1

Set to open April 2, 2021

ELIGIBILITY
Residents that are fully vaccinated against COVID-19 will be eligible to have, at minimum, 1 hour of visitation per month.
Each visit will be restricted to 1 adult or 1 adult visitor and the resident's child/children per month **All visitors must be approved visitors prior to scheduling a visit**
SCHEDULING
Visitation will be offered 5 days per week
Monday, Wednesday, Friday: 6:15 pm MDT – 8:00 pm MDT
Saturday and Sunday: 9:00 am MDT - 3:45 pm MDT
All visitation must be scheduled prior to the visit with Control at 701-579-5100 at least 48 hours prior
All visits that include children will be allowed up to 2 hours per visit and will be scheduled individually
Adult only visits may include up to 3 residents and their 1 adult visitor each for a total of 6 visitors and residents in the visitation room.
STAGING AREA
Visitation will be held in the visitation room
All visitors (ages 5 and up) must wear a facility-issued mask upon entrance to the facility. Failure to wear the PPE will result in termination of the visit.
Facility-issued masks and eye protection will be required for all residents
The visitor and resident will be seated across from each other at a table
In the event there is more than one adult visit at a time, all visiting cohorts will be seated at least 6 feet apart
SCREENING UPON ACCESS
Visitors must arrive 30 minutes prior to the visit so temperature checks and the ND DOCR COVID-19 Supplemental Screenings can be completed. Failure to pass the screening will result in termination of the visit
All visitors will be required to submit to a BINAX Test prior to the visit. A positive result would prevent the visitor from visiting.
SANITATION
Before the next visit occurs, the visiting room must sit for 15 minutes to allow escaped droplets to settle to the surfaces. As such, visits must have a 30-minute intermission and the visiting room should be sanitized by the visiting officer utilizing the HOTSYS sprayer.
Sanitation supplies will be provided at each visit to include hand sanitizer and sanitizing wipes
REGULATIONS
All previous regulations relating to the authorization of visits will be maintained and the standard rules of visitation shall apply.
One brief embrace will be authorized at the beginning and end of each visit for each adult visitor/resident. Kissing is not allowed. Children will be allowed to have physical contact with their mothers throughout the visit.
No food or drink is allowed in the visitation room
Photographs are not allowed at this time
Residents are allowed to send out property
