On September 11, 2025, the North Dakota Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation ("ND DOCR") completed an inspection of the McIntosh County Court Holding, which has an operational capacity of two (2) and graded as a grade four (4) correctional facility under N.D.C.C. § 12-44.1-06.

The inspection was made in accordance with N.D.C.C. § 12-44.1-24. The inspection generally includes a tour of the court holding area. The inspection also includes a review of the fire inspection report, life safety, booking logs, and security criteria.

On the date of completing the inspection of the McIntosh County Court Holding area, the McIntosh County Court Holding was determined not to be in use and had held no persons in the past year. Inspectors were not able to view the holding area or the fire inspection report.

A facility inspection must be completed prior to holding anyone in the McIntosh County Court Holding.
